A Snapshot of Bullying in Australian Schools





- There are 3.893.834 students enrolled in 9.477 schools.
- There are 4.7 million Gen Z, aged between 10-24, in Australia who are in schools and higher education providers.
- There are **2 billion** Gen Zs globally.
- · Today's Gen Z students will make up one third (33%) of the Australian workforce by 2028.



Bullying in schools is a serious problem in Australia

Three out of five students (59%) have experienced bullying. That's 2.3 million students nationally.

One in five students (20%) admitted they had bullied

Three out of five (57%) sav experiencina bullvina upsets them a lot/areat deal

Types of bullying experienced by those who have been bullied include:



Verbal



Via social media



Physical



Via text message



Other (answers included social exclusion, aossipina, emotional/mental)

One in seven students who are bullied do not speak to anvone (14%).

That's **340,656 students** in Australia who stay silent.









Bullied students who do speak up are most likely to talk to parents (27%) and friends (24%).





Impacts of Make Bullying History Foundation Seminars

Evaluation of Bullying Seminar



96% rated the seminar 'excellent', 'very good' or 'good'



95% found the seminar helpful

MBHF improves student confidence to handle bullying

Students were asked how confident they were to deal with bullying before and after the seminar.



One in two were extremely/very confident to handle bullying.



Three out of four were extremely/very confident to handle bullying.


